### \*Miscellaneous Topics:

- Kim mentioned that extra chrome books/cart have been requested since the school class sizes are growing
  - o Cost: Approx. \$10,000 (36 chrome books/cart)
  - Marcie will get us a quote and that will give Frances time to look over our funds.
  - o Chad will work on company donations for chrome book costs
- Jenna mentioned setting up a "Field Trip Fund." This way the teachers won't have to use money from their \$300 teacher fund to pay for the field trip activity.
  - Field trips cost \$300-\$350. The school pays for the cost of the bus ride through money raised from movie night.
  - o \$400/grade (6 grades) would be \$2,400 needed in the Field Trip Fund
  - o Melinda motioned to approve \$2,400 for Field Trip Fund
  - o Chad 2nd it
  - o Approved!
  - o TK/K field trip to Bishop's increased this year. If needed, Marcie and Frances will work together to see which teacher(s) need to have their \$300 teacher fund reimbursed.
- Jenna brought up having incentives at our meetings as a way to get people to attend. What can we do to get more people to come? Raffle?
  - Marcie mentioned making ourselves available at pick-up with info on upcoming events, etc. We could also work together to put more info in the monthly school newsletter.
  - Melinda mentioned setting up a PTO booth
  - o Chad mentioned a monthly newsletter
