- Treasurer's Report

Frances stated that currently have \$18,524.05 in our account. There is \$10,566.93 left of budgeted expenditures, which leaves us with \$7,957.12 in available funds. There is also \$1,000 pending from Kohl's.

- Family Dinner

Total Profit was \$1,681.65. For our family dinner next year, we would have it earlier in the year, lower prices to \$10/\$5, have two seatings and include more silent auction and/or raffle items. We will have the pizza party for students on Tuesday 4/25 at 1:30 pm.

- PTO Movie Night

Marcie asked if PTO would put on a movie night and use the profit to upgrade the school's equipment. It's scheduled it for Friday 4/21, showing the movie Sing.

- PR Issues

It was suggested to change the PTO Facebook page from a page to a group. We need to promote meetings, encourage involvement and educate parents on PTO's role. We also need to keep parents aware of all the purchases PTO makes for the school so they realize why we are fundraising!

- Croc Run

Scheduled for 5/12 from 11-2:30, with an assembly rally on 4/21 from 1:30-2:30. Our goal is to raise \$8,000. Spirit week will lead up to the Croc run with M: pajama day, T: class color day, W: Sports day, Th: -er day, F: Cobblestone green day. Set up from 11-12, Kindergarten runs 12-12:30, 1st from 12:30-1, 2nd and 3rd from 1-1:30, 4th and 5th from 1:30-2, clean up 2-2:30. Students run for 15 minutes. Water bottles have been ordered (each participant gets one), Jenna got a great deal and we have 430 for \$319.77. If students bring in over \$40 in pledges, they will be invited to a special party at school. Prizes for top money raised will be a basketball hoop, American Girl doll, and a bike. Top runners in
